

Broncs set school mark

KNOXVILLE, Tenn. — A 4x800-meter foursome of Chris Tarello, Mike Loughran, Marc McKithen and Ron Brock clocked 7:34.48 for fourth place at the Sea Ray Relays here yesterday, setting a Rider school record. Brock then ran a personal best 3:52.31 in the 1,500 and Garyl Moore high jumped 6-8.

The rest of the Broncs went to the Lehigh Invitational at Bethlehem, Pa., where top efforts were:

MEN— Jesse Breeden, 2d, 1,500 (4:01.5) and fourth, 800 (1:56.0); Matt Distlehurst, 2d, discus (135-9); Eric Eberman, 4th, 100 hurdles (15.3); Adam Slaninko, 5th, shot (47-1), and Mark Lamperl, 5th, 800 (1:56.6).

WOMEN— Jen Billups, 2d, triple jump (35-10) and 3d, high jump (5-2); Linda Wilson, 4th, 400 (1:00.7); Janine Minehan, 5th, 800 (2:24.6), and Kathy Guimes, 5th, javelin (105-8).

At the Sea Ray Relays hosted by U of Tennessee, the 4x800 relay team of Chris Tarello (Medford), Mike Loughran (Yardley), Marc McKithen (Trenton) and Ron Brock (Riverside) set a new Rider record with a time of 7:34.48. Brock also ran the 1500m in 3:52.31. At Lehigh, Jesse Breeden (Levittown) was 2nd in the 1500 (4:01.5) and 4th in the 800m (1:56.0). Matt Distlehurst (Woodcliff Lake) placed second in the discus (135'9"), Jen Billups (Farmingdale, NY) was 2nd in the triple jump (35'10") and 3rd in the long jump (15'7.5"). Junior Jen Molinelli (Toms River) placed 2nd in the high jump (5'2").
