EAST GREENWICH, R.I. -- Lincoln Sudbury, the top-ranked girls' division 1 team by the Massachusetts State Track Coaches Association, finished fourth yesterday in brisk and muddy conditions at the 24th Brown Invitational at Goddard Park.

More than 3,000 runners from 185 teams competed in the meet, one of the biggest in the Northeast, featuring teams from Maine and New Jersey.

North Kingstown dominated the girls' race, winning with 56 points. Lincoln-Sudbury finished fourth with 104 points, followed by Bishop Feehan (124) and Marshfield (158).

Junior Dana Jameison led Lincoln-Sudbury, finishing in 18:42.
